Dear Mr. Johnson,

On February 21, 2019, Cascadia Water, LLC (“Cascadia”) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (the “Commission”) its Application for the Sale and Transfer of Assets from Estates Water Systems, Inc. (“Estates”) to Cascadia (“Application”). In connection with this Application, Cascadia also requested approval of a revised tariff for Cascadia and provided a draft customer notice, informing Estates’ customers of the proposed ownership transfer.

Cascadia sent the notice to customers on March 9, 2019. Pursuant to WAC 480-143-210(1), customers must be provided with notice thirty days before the transfer is scheduled for Commission action. As a result, Cascadia’s revised tariff will not be effective until after the thirty-day period for consideration of the transfer. In keeping with this revised timeline, Cascadia is filing updated tariff sheets with an effective date of April 15, 2019 (see attached Revised Exhibit 4 to the Application).
