Staff's Request to Cancel Payment Arrangements
Docket TV-190498

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On November 13, 2019, the commission issued Order 02 in this docket, classifying Yakima Brothers, LLC as a common carrier of household goods within the state of Washington, ordering the company not to operate as a household goods carrier without a permit, and assessing a penalty of \$5,000. Order 02 also suspended \$4,500 of the penalty on the condition the company not operate without a permit, and pay the remaining \$500 as agreed upon in the payment schedule in Appendix A.¹ If the company failed to make the required payments, the entire amount of the penalty including the suspended portion of \$4,500 would immediately become due and payable without further order by the commission.

As of today, Yakima Brothers LLC made one \$100 payment on November 13, 2019, but failed to make December 13, 2019, January 13, 2020, and February 13, 2020, payments. Staff requests the commission cancel the payment arrangements and that the \$4,900 balance of the penalty, including the \$4,500 suspended portion, become immediately due and payable.
