RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Ray Hahne Commission Staff's Recommendation to Waive Suspended Penalties of Order 02 Docket TG-190844

Dear Ms. Maxwell:

On November 25, 2021, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 02, which assessed Ray Hahne (Hahne or Company) a penalty of \$2,000 for operating as a solid waste carrier without a certificate. Order 02 further suspended a \$2,000 portion of the penalty for a period of two years on the conditions that: (1) the Company refrains permanently from further operations as a solid waste carrier in the state of Washington without first obtaining the required certificate.

To date, Hahne has refrained permanently from further operations as a solid waste carrier in this state. Staff finds that Hahne satisfied the conditions of Order 02 and recommends that the \$2,000 suspended penalty be waived.
