TO ALL PARTIES:

On June 12, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Granting Mitigation in Part; Imposing and Suspending Penalty (Order 01) against Joel Cisneros d/b/a Always Movin' Moving Company (Always Moving or Company). Order 01 imposed a penalty of \$1,500 against Merchants, \$1,000 of which was suspended for two years, to be waived thereafter, subject to the conditions that: a) Always Moving not incur any repeat violations of acute or critical regulations upon re-inspection, and b) the Company timely pay the \$500 portion of the penalty that was not suspended.

On May 4, 2022, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that the Company had timely paid the \$500 portion of the penalty that was not suspended and that the Company has not incurred any further violations of acute or critical regulations upon re-inspection.

The Commission finds that Always Moving has complied with the conditions of Order 01. The \$1,000 portion of the penalty that was suspended is now waived, and this docket is closed.
