On June 30, 2003, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (WUTC) issued Order No. 06 in Docket No. UT-030614.¹ This order, which is also attached to the e-mail containing this memorandum, required all CLECs providing business service in the state of Washington to file certain data with the Commission by July 18, 2003. As a part of the data request, if a CLEC was providing some or all of its services via resale, UNE-P or unbundled loop wholesale services provided by Qwest, it was required to verify that the quantities of these services that Qwest submitted in its competitive classification petition for its company were accurate. Qwest mistakenly assumed that because it had already provided this data in response to a data request from the Commission Staff that the CLECs would receive the data directly from Staff. As this was not the case, Qwest is now submitting for your review (attached file labeled xxxxx) your company's specific data regarding the quantities of resale, UNE-P, and unbundled loop services your company was purchasing from Qwest as of 12/31/02. Qwest is coordinating this effort with Commission Staff, and has been directed by Staff representative Tom Wilson to direct you to send your e-mail verification directly to him, via e-mail, at twilson@wutc.wa.gov. Thank you in advance for your attention in this matter.
