NATURE OF THE PROCEEDING. This is a complaint proceeding brought by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission), through its staff, against Qwest Corporation (Qwest) and 13 other telecommunications companies alleging that the companies entered into certain

interconnection agreements identified in Exhibit A to the Amended Complaint,¹ and failed to file, or timely file, the agreements with the Commission as required by state and federal law. The complaint also alleges that the companies entered into certain agreements to resolve disputes, but that the agreements violated federal and state law by failing to make terms and conditions available to other requesting carriers, providing unreasonable preferences, and engaging in rate discrimination.

- 2 PREHEARING CONFERENCE. The Commission convened a prehearing conference in this docket at Olympia, Washington on March 30,2004, before Administrative Law Judge Ann E. Rendahl. The purpose of the prehearing conference was to determine the status of the proceeding since the Commission entered Order No. 05 on February 12, 2004, determine whether it is possible to narrow the issues or consider stipulations of facts or issues, and establish a procedural schedule for the proceeding.

- 4 **PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE.** The parties agreed upon a procedural schedule during the conference. The Commission adopts this procedural schedule, which is attached to this Order as Appendix B, and incorporated into the body of this Order by this reference.
- NOTICE OF HEARING. The Commission will hold an evidentiary hearing in this proceeding during the week of November 1-5, 2004. The hearing will be held in Room 206, Chandler Plaza Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington, beginning at 9:30 a.m., on November 1, 2004.
- NOTICE OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE. The Commission convenes a prehearing conference in this matter to collect and mark exhibits and cross-examination exhibits, discuss time estimates for cross-examination, and address all other pending issues prior to the hearings scheduled to begin November 1, 2004. The conference will be held in Room 108, Chandler Plaza Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington at 9:30 a.m., on Tuesday, October 26, 2004.

- Each party must provide to the Commission by **Noon on Monday, October 25**, **2004**, a list of the party's witnesses appearing at the hearing, estimates of cross-examination time for other parties' witnesses, a list of exhibits the party plans to sponsor in the hearing, and a list of any cross-examination exhibits the party plans to offer during the hearing. Parties are granted a one–day extension of time to file paper copies of these documents with the Commission pursuant to WAC 480-07-145(6), and must submit these documents to the Commission electronically by Noon on October 25, 2004. Parties must bring to the October 26, 2004, prehearing conference **five** paper copies of all cross-examination exhibits they plan to offer at the hearing, and must file with the Commission an original and any remaining copies required to be filed.
- BOCUMENT PREPARATION AND FILING REQUIREMENTS. Parties must file with the Commission an original plus 12 copies of all pleadings, motions, briefs, and other prefiled materials. Paper copies of these materials are required to conform to the format and publication guidelines set forth in WAC 480-07-395 and 480-07-460, and must be three-hole punched with *oversized* holes to allow easy handling. The Commission may require a party to refile any document that fails to conform to these standards.
- All filings must be mailed to the Commission's Executive Secretary, Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, P.O. Box 47250, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive, S.W. Olympia, Washington 98504-7250, or delivered by hand to the Commission's Executive Secretary at the Commission's Records Center at the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive, S.W., Olympia, Washington, 98504. Both the post office box and street address are required to expedite deliveries by the U.S. Postal Service.
- An electronic copy of all filings must be provided by e-mail delivery to records@wutc.wa.gov. Alternatively, Parties may furnish an electronic copy

by delivering with each filing a 3.5-inch IBM-formatted high-density diskette including the filed document(s). The Commission prefers that parties furnish electronic copies in .pdf (Adobe Acrobat) format, supplemented by a separate file in MS Word 6.0 (or later), or WordPerfect 5.1 (or later) format. Parties are required to organize and identify electronic files as specified in WAC 480-07-140(5).

- 11 ELECTRONIC SUBMISSION OF DOCUMENTS. Parties may only submit documents electronically with the Commission in this proceeding with the permission of the administrative law judge. Under WAC 480-07-145(6), electronic submission of documents provides a one-day extension of the paper-filing requirement. If, at any time during this proceeding, parties are authorized to submit documents with the Commission electronically under WAC 480-07-145(6), Parties must submit the document to records@wutc.wa.gov, and file an original, plus 12 copies, of the document with the Commission by the following business day.
- NOTICE TO PARTIES: Any objection to the provisions of this Order must be filed within ten (10) days after the service date of this Order, pursuant to WAC 480-07-430 and WAC 480-07-810. Absent such objection, this Order will control further proceedings in this matter, subject to Commission review.
