Please explain why Mr. Applegate believes the shifting of risks from ratepayers to PSE that results from his proposal is only a "theoretical" risk and provide all analyses performed to reach that determination.

RESPONSE:

Deferred recognition of storm damage expense assures that rates will eventually recover storm damages costs. By contrast, the 6-year average only reflects costs from the prior 6-years. If PSE infrequently or irregularly filed general rate cases, then it could be said that PSE is placed at risk for storm damages that occur prior to the 6-year period and storm damages that are reflected in rates for less than 6 years. Since PSE files general rate cases on a regular and frequent basis, that risk is "theoretical".
