**RE: Benefits of the Targeted Electrification Pilot Phase 2**

Witness Mannetti testifies that “PSE will engage The Cadmus Group to evaluate each program offering of the Targeted Electrification Pilot Phase 2.” Mannetti, Exh. JM-1CT at 24:17-18.

- a. At what frequency does PSE intend to evaluate each program within TEP Phase 2? Does PSE intend to evaluate each program throughout their implementation?
- b. Does PSE intend to share findings for the evaluation with interested parties? If yes, then how?
- c. With the passage of HB 1589, how does PSE intend to incorporate the results and learnings of TEP Phase 2 into future company plans?

**Response:**

- a. Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) aims to leverage its Program Evaluator to evaluate Targeted Electrification Pilot (“TEP”) Phase 2 after 2025, the first year of the program cycle. This will enable findings that may inform subsequent program work to be more quickly incorporated after TEP Phase 2 is complete.
- b. Yes. At this time, PSE does not have specific plans, but at a minimum the evaluation would be shared with relevant PSE advisory groups, as appropriate.
- c. As the TEP Phase 2 has not yet begun, PSE does not have a specific plan in place to incorporate results and learnings, but PSE regularly incorporates the results of pilot programs into future company plans.
