1. Public Counsel hereby offers in response to Bench Request No. 2, the Public Comment Exhibit for admission into the record of the proceeding.

2. Bench Request No. 2r - Public Comment Exhibit. The exhibit consists of remarks given by telephone, e-mail, and other written materials, including a letter, submitted by the public to comment on PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company's ("Pacific Power" or "PacifiCorp") petition for a rate increase. The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("Commission") and the Public Counsel Unit of the Washington Attorney General's Office ("Public Counsel") received and compiled these comments.

3. Pacific Power customers provided comments via the telephone, e-mail, letter, and through the Commission's online comment web portal.
