1 **Penalty:** On July 5, 2006, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a penalty in the amount of \$100 against R2C Communications, Inc., (R2C Communications) for one violation of WAC 480-120-382, which requires competitively classified telecommunications companies to file annual reports with the commission no later than May 1 of each year.

2 **Petition for Mitigation:** On July 14, 2006, respondent filed a petition for mitigation and waived a hearing. R2C Communications stated that it had never conducted business in the state of Washington and requested that its registration be withdrawn.

3 **Answer:** On August 2, 2006, Commission Staff responded to the petition for mitigation. Staff asserted that, on July 31, 2006, under Docket UT-061245, R2C Communications requested approval to voluntarily withdraw its registration in Washington. Because R2C Communications stated that it does not provide service in Washington and requested to withdraw its registration, Staff supported mitigation of the penalty.

4 **Commission Decision:** The Commission grants the petition for mitigation. R2C Communications does not conduct any business in the state of Washington and requested approval to voluntarily withdraw its registration. During the Commission's August 16, 2006, Open Meeting, the Commission considered and approved the request in Docket UT-061245 to withdraw R2C Communication's registration. Accordingly, the petition to mitigate the penalty is granted.

5 It is so ordered.
