STIPULATION RE: REVISED TESTIMONY AND EXHIBITS OF TIMOTHY HOGAN

The parties stipulate as follows:

- 1. The revised testimony and exhibits of Timothy Hogan may be admitted into evidence only for the purpose of supporting WNG's claim for "an appropriate" working capital allowance for certain expenditures associated with remedial action at the Tacoma Tar Pits CERCLA site. It is not to be considered evidence in support of WNG's proposed environmental tracker. Cross-examination of Mr. Hogan should be limited to the purposes set forth above.
- 2. Should WNG seek to renew its efforts to have the Commission consider its environmental tracker and wish to have the revised Hogan testimony considered for that purpose, WNG shall make Mr. Hogan available for crossexamination in the context of that proceeding.
- 3. By stipulating that the Hogan testimony may be admitted into evidence, the Commission Staff, Public Counsel, and the Intervenors do not waive any right to contest on any grounds the environmental tracker or any of WNG's STIPULATION RE: REVISED TESTIMONY - 1 AND EXHIBITS OF TIMOTHY HOGAN

environmental expenditures at the Tacoma Tar Pits CERCLA site or elsewhere, nor waive any right to crossexamination of Mr. Hogan in this proceeding.
