In accordance with WAC 480-07-640, Qwest submits an original and two (2) copies of the following amendment for Commission approval: Triennial Review Order Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") and ICG Telecom Group, Inc. This amendment changes and adds terms, conditions and rates for certain network elements due to the requirements under the Federal Communications Commission's Triennial Review Order pertaining to Qwest's offering of selected network elements on an unbundled basis.
