- 1 A brief adjudicative proceeding was held on Commission Staff’s petition to suspend registration of 54 telecommunications companies for failure to pay regulatory fees and file annual reports on July 6, 2001, before Lawrence J. Berg.
- 2 On July 18, 2001, the administrative law judge entered an Initial Order. Of the 54 companies, one company subsequently complied with its legal duties and was dismissed from this proceeding. Another company requested that its registration be cancelled by the Commission. Registrations for the other 52 companies were revoked by the Initial Order. The Initial Order, including an appendix listing the 52 companies whose registrations were revoked, was served on all parties of record pursuant to WAC 480-09-120.
- 3 No petition for administrative review was filed within the 21 days allowed by rule for filing. In accordance with RCW 34.05.485 and WAC 480-09-500, the Commission on August 17, 2001, accepted the findings of fact and conclusions of law, and adopted the Initial Order as its own for purposes of this proceeding (“Final Order”). However, the Commission’s Final Order was filed and served on the parties without the appendix referred to in the Order.
- 4 Accordingly, the Commission enters this Errata Order to cure any procedural defect that may exist regarding the entry and service of the Final Order dated August 17, 2001.

ORDER

5 THE COMMISSION ORDERS That the Initial Order entered in this brief
adjudication on July 18, 2001, is affirmed and adopted for purposes of this
proceeding.

THE COMMISSION FURTHER ORDERS That:

6 (1) Registrations for the 52 telecommunications companies identified in
Appendix A to this Order are revoked.
