OBJECTION TO PREHEARING CONFERENCE ORDER

- The Commission Staff requests the February 28, 2003 Prehearing Conference Order be amended to state the following:
 - 1. When a party files evidence with the Commission, that party shall serve the other parties with supporting workpapers as defined in WAC 480-09-330(1)(a).
 - 2. The list of issues in \P 7 of the Prehearing Conference Order is not exclusive.
- With respect to Item 1 above, a workpaper filing requirement was discussed at the prehearing conference, and no party objected to such a requirement. We assume its omission from the Prehearing Conference Order was an oversight. Accordingly, we request such a requirement be formally included.

With respect to Item 2, Commission Staff assumes the listing of issued in ¶ 7 of the Prehearing Conference Order is not exclusive. Other issues were identified at the prehearing conference and in the Notice of Prehearing Conference (February 14, 2003).

On the other hand, if the Commission wishes the Prehearing Conference Order to contain a complete list of issues that are known at this time, Commission Staff is prepared to contribute to such a list.

Accordingly, we request the February 28, 2003 Prehearing Conference Order be amended to add the two conditions identified in paragraph 1 above.
