1	II. BACKGROUND INFORMATION
2	
3	PSE is a public utility engaged in the business of rendering electrical and natural
4	gas service to the public in certain areas of the State of Washington including service to
5	areas located within the boundaries of a number of reservations located in western Washington
6	State, including the Lummi and Swinomish Reservations. No hearing or prehearing conference
7	has been scheduled in this docket, and thus this petition is timely pursuant to WAC 480-09-430.
8 9	III. INTEREST IN PROCEEDING
10	PSE was a party in Docket No. UT-911306 concerning taxation by the Lummi Tribe
11	and Docket Nos. UE-010990 and UE-010995 concerning taxation by the Swinomish Tribe and
12	therefore has a direct interest in the subject matters involved in this docket. The Yakima
13	Nation's Franchise Ordinance requires that utilities operating on the reservation enter into
14	franchise agreements and pay a franchise fee under that Ordinance. The Lummi and Swinomish
15	Ordinances also impose a tax on utilities operating within the Reservation boundaries.
16	The Swinomish tax was the subject of a Formal Complaint (Docket Nos. UE-010990
17	and UE-010995 were consolidated with Docket Nos. UT-010988, TG-010989, UT-010966 and
18	TG-011084) where the Commission reviewed and confirmed its policy in regards to Indian
19	Tribal taxes that was established in Docket No. UT-911306. This complaint by Public Counsel
20	seems to be challenging that policy therefore PSE and its customers may be directly affected by
21	the Commission's action in this Docket.

1	IV. SCOPE OF PARTICIPATION		
2			
3	PSE's intervention will not broaden the issues to be addressed nor unduly burden the record or		
4	delay the proceedings. As noted above, PSE is interested in changes to the Commission's		
5	policy that could result from this proceeding.

8	V. RELIEF REQUESTED

10	WHEREFORE, PSE respectfully requests leave to intervene as a party to this proceeding, to file		
11	1 a petition in intervention; with right to discovery; to have notice of and appear at the taking of		
12	2 testimony; to produce and cross-examine witnesses; and to be heard in person or by counsel on		
13	brief and at oral argument.
