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- JUDGE WALLIS: Let's be on the record,
- 2 please. The conference will please to come to order.
- 3 This is a prehearing conference in the matter of
- 4 Commission Docket Number TG-030812, which is an
- 5 application of Ed's Disposal, Inc. for an extension
- 6 of its Certificate Number G-110 for a certificate of
- 7 public convenience and necessity to operate motor
- 8 vehicles in furnishing solid waste collection
- 9 service.
- 10 This conference is being held at Olympia,
- 11 Washington, before Administrative Law Judge C.
- 12 Robert Wallis, pursuant to due and proper notice to
- 13 all interested persons.
- 14 Let's begin by asking parties for
- 15 appearances, please. Mr. Sells.
- 16 MR. SELLS: Thank you. If Your Honor
- 17 please, James Sells, Attorney at Law, 9657 Levin
- 18 Road, Silverdale, 98383. Telephone 360-307-8860;
- 19 fax, 360-307-8865; e-mail, jimsells@rsulaw.com,
- 20 representing Applicant, Ed's Disposal.
- JUDGE WALLIS: Other appearances?
- MS. SMITH: Yes, Your Honor, Shannon Smith,
- 23 Assistant Attorney General, appearing on behalf of
- 24 Commission Staff, 1400 South Evergreen Park Drive,
- 25 S.W., P.O. Box 40128, Olympia, Washington 98504-0128.

- JUDGE WALLIS: Are there any other
- 4 appearances to be made? Let the record show that
- 5 there is no response.
- 6 For the record, let me state that this
- 7 matter arises under Chapter 81.77 of the Revised Code
- 8 of Washington, which requires the Commission to
- 9 restrict grants of authority in cases where territory
- 10 is within the service territory of another operator
- 11 to a decision made upon a record after hearing, and
- 12 consequently, we are holding this hearing in the
- 13 absence of a protest to the application.
- 14 Let the record show that there was no
- 15 petition for intervention received, and no
- 16 appearances, other than the Applicant and Commission
- 17 Staff, were made today.
- 18 The Commission, in the notice of prehearing
- 19 conference, asked the Applicant to submit any
- 20 information that it wished to provide to the
- 21 Commission in considering this application. The
- 22 Applicant has done so. Is that correct, Mr. Sells?
- MR. SELLS: Yes, Your Honor.
- JUDGE WALLIS: The notice of hearing also
- 25 indicated that, in light of the circumstances, I

- 1 would ask the parties whether there is any objection
- 2 to a waiver of an initial order and to submission of
- 3 this matter to the Commission upon a written record?
- 4 MR. SELLS: No objection.
- 5 JUDGE WALLIS: Is there any objection?
- 6 MS. SMITH: No, Your Honor.
- 7 JUDGE WALLIS: Is there anything that the
- 8 Applicant wishes to add in way of explanation to the
- 9 information that has been submitted? Mr. Sells.
- 10 MR. SELLS: Thank you. If Your Honor
- 11 please, we have submitted a statement of the
- 12 operations manager, Derek Dietrich. Attached to that
- 13 a recent financial statement, equipment list, copy of
- 14 the certificate, copy of the most recent tariff and
- 15 insurance certificate.
- I can advise the Commission that this
- 17 territory has been served by Ed's Disposal since
- 18 1982, under the mistaken belief that it was part of
- 19 G-110. As so often has been the case, due to the
- 20 mapping project, we have found out that it is not.
- 21 There's approximately 50 residential customers
- 22 primarily who have always had Ed's. It's our
- 23 understanding that Waste Management has no desire to
- 24 serve this territory, as they've always considered it
- 25 to be Ed's, and have so indicated on the record.

- 1 JUDGE WALLIS: Let me state that the file in
- 2 this matter does include a statement from Ms. Polly
- 3 McNeill, on behalf of Waste Management, stating facts
- 4 as you've indicated and that they specifically do not
- 5 protest his application.
- 6 MR. SELLS: That's my understanding, Your
- 7 Honor. So we're prepared to submit it on the record.
- 8 JUDGE WALLIS: Very well. Does Commission
- 9 Staff have anything to add?
- 10 MS. SMITH: No, Your Honor, Staff does not
- 11 have anything to add, other than the fact to say that
- 12 Staff sees no problems or concerns with respect to
- 13 this application.
- 14 JUDGE WALLIS: Very well. Is there anything
- 15 further that any of the parties would like to add for
- 16 the record at this time?
- MR. SELLS: No, Your Honor.
- 18 MS. SMITH: I was just going to note that
- 19 this might be a record.
- JUDGE WALLIS: All right. Well, it's a
- 21 dubious record, I'm sure, as far as the court
- 22 reporter is concerned, but we did try to set this in
- 23 conjunction with another matter. The other matter,
- 24 however, did settle prior to today's hearing.
- There being nothing further to come before

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     the Commission at this time, this matter is
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     adjourned, and a final order will be entered by the
    Commission at the earliest feasible date. Thank you
