The Fragaria Landing Water Company, Inc. (Fragaria) revised procedural schedule (Order 03) calls for commission staff to file testimony on September 6, 2006. Staff and Fragaria have engaged in productive discussions and are working towards settlement of remaining issues. Once a settlement is reached, the parties will need to work out the details and subsequently reduce it to writing.

Accordingly, the parties believe that at this time it is an unnecessary and an additional burden to simultaneously file testimony while these negotiations occur.
