injunction against the defendant, (3) impose a civil penalty in the amount of \$30,000, and (4) award costs and fees, including reasonable attorneys' fees, as described below.

4. Plaintiff is entitled to the relief sought in the petition for enforcement.

III. ORDER

Based on the above findings of fact and conclusions of law, Judgment is entered as follows:

- 1. Defendant Daniel Busby is directed to comply with Commission Order 02, a Final Order effective February 29, 2008, issued to defendant Daniel Busby in Commission Docket TV-071670, by immediately ceasing and desisting from conducting in-state household goods moving operations in Washington state requiring permit authority under RCW 81.80.075, without a permit issued by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission.
- 2. Defendant Daniel Busby and all successors, assigns, and transferees are hereby enjoined and permanently restrained from directly or indirectly engaging in any of the following conduct:
 - Engaging in business as a household goods carrier by transporting
 household goods for compensation, by motor vehicle between points in
 Washington state, without first obtaining a household goods common
 carrier permit from the Washington Utilities and Transportation
 Commission.
 - b. Engaging in business as a household goods carrier by advertising,

1	soliciting, offering, or entering into an agreement to transport household			
2	goods, without first obtaining a household goods common carrier permit			
3	from the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission.			
4	3. Defendant Daniel Busby is directed to pay a civil penalty of \$30,000 for			
5	engaging in business as a household goods carrier in violation of a cease and			
7	desist order issued by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission			
8	under RCW 81.04.510.			
9	4. Plaintiff is awarded costs and fees and other disbursements associated with the			
10	filing and maintenance of its petition for enforcement, including reasonable			
11	attorneys' fees, in the amount of \$601.			
12	5. The Court retains jurisdiction to enforce this Order.
