WASTE MANAGEMENT OF WASHINGTON, INC.'S RESPONSE TO STERICYCLE'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME AND FOR EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION

- 1. Waste Management of Washington, Inc. d/b/a WM-Healthcare Solutions ("Waste Management"), by and through Summit Law Group, hereby submits this response to Stericycle's Motion for Extension of Time and for Expedited Consideration. Waste Management does not oppose an extension, but it adamantly objects to Stericycle's request that the response date be left open in the manner requested.
 - Waste Management filed and served a Motion to Dismiss Stericycle's Complaint and Petition on April 12, 2011. The Motion was accepted in hard copy by the Commission's Records Center on April 13, 2011. Under WAC 480-07-380(1)(c), the responses to Waste Management's Motion to Dismiss are due ten (10) days after filing, on Monday, April 25, 2011. There is no evidence of hardship or unreasonable burden for Stericycle to file its response in a timely fashion. The Motion was properly served and filed, and the parties had ample notice of the regulation that establishes the date for responding. Indeed, the issues were discussed freely at the Open Meeting on April 14. Waste Management objects to an extension of time that allows for factual evidence to be developed through stipulations or discovery and believes that any motions for summary determination should be scheduled separately. However, more than that unfairly benefits Stericycle, to Waste Management's
