TO ALL PARTIES:

On May 7, 2018, the Commission issued a penalty assessment against Tomas Castellon, d/b/a Bulldog Concrete Services, LLC, (Bulldog Concrete or Company) for one violation of RCW 19.122. In the penalty assessment, the Commission offered to suspend and ultimately waive an \$800 portion of the penalty on the conditions that Bulldog Concrete pay a \$200 portion of the penalty, that Bulldog Concrete employees attend Dig Safe training provided by the National Utility Contractors Association (NUCA) within 12 months of the date of the penalty assessment, and that the Company commit no further violations of RCW 19.122 during those 12 months.

On March 22, 2018, Bulldog Concrete payed the \$200 portion of the penalty that was not suspended and filed a response to the penalty assessment, accepting the conditions offered.

On November 15, 2019, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that Bulldog Concrete has not attended NUCA Dig Safe training, and recommending the Commission impose the \$800 suspended portion of the penalty.

Due to the Company's failure to comply with the agreed conditions by attending NUCA Dig Safe training, the remaining \$800 portion of the penalty is now due and payable.
