TO ALL PARTIES:

On August 8, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 02, Stipulated Initial Order Classifying Respondent as Charter Party or Excursion Service Carrier; Ordering Respondent to Cease and Desist; Imposing and Suspending Penalties on Condition of Future Compliance (Order 02) against Latin Limousine, LLC, d/b/a HR Limousine, (Latin Limousine or Company). Order 02 imposed a penalty of \$10,000 against Latin Limousine, \$9,000 of which was suspended for two years, to be waived thereafter, subject to the conditions that: a) Latin Limousine refrain from operating as a charter party or excursion carrier in Washington without first obtaining the required certificate, and b) Latin Limousine pay the \$1,000 portion of the penalty that was not suspended.

On July 30, 2020, Staff filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that the Company had timely paid the \$1,000 portion of the penalty that was not suspended and that Staff believes the Company has refrained from operating as a charter party or excursion service carrier without a certificate. The Company's charter and excursion authority was reinstated in October 25, 2018, in Docket TE-180620 and subsequently voluntarily canceled in Docket TE-200545 due to the economic effects of the COVID-19 pandemic. Staff recommends the suspended penalty be waived.

The Commission finds that Latin Limousine has complied with the conditions of Order 02. The \$9,000 portion of the penalty that was suspended is now waived, and this docket is closed.
