- Q. Please state your name and business address.
- A. My name is Ahmed Mubashir. My business address is 1100-10830 Jasper
 Avenue, Edmonton, Alberta T5J 2B3, Canada.
- Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?
- A. I am employed by the Alberta Investment Management Corporation, as a Portfolio Manager in the Infrastructure and Timber group.
- Q. What are your duties as Portfolio Manager for Infrastructure and Timber?
- A. As Portfolio Manager for Infrastructure and Timber, I have two categories of responsibilities.
