Dear Local Hazardous Waste Billing Partners:

Thank you for your ongoing work to collect and forward the Local Hazardous Waste fees from the residents and businesses you serve, as required by King County Board of Health Code 11.04.

In March, we notified you that the King County Board of Health was considering adjustments to the Local Hazardous Waste fees. The Board of Health made a final decision on June 21, 2018.

The Board of Health considered several potential rate plans before approving a multiyear adjustment to Local Hazardous Waste Management Program fees. Starting in 2019, fees will be increased 5.4 percent annually for the next four years (2019-2022). This adjustment was needed to address cumulative impacts of inflation since the last rate increase in 2012. The new fees are scheduled to take effect in January 2019. The new rate schedule is shown in the table below.
