RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. A-Star Limousine LLC Commission Staff's Recommendation to Waive Suspended Penalty in Order 02 Docket TE-190053

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On March 12, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) entered Order 02 in Docket TE-190053, which assessed A-Star Limousine LLC (A-Star Limousine or company) a penalty of \$10,000 for operating as a charter or excursion service carrier in the state of Washington without the required certificate. Order 02 further suspended a \$9,000 portion of the penalty for a period of two years, before being waived, on the conditions that: (1) the company refrained permanently from further operations as a charter or excursion service carrier without first obtaining the required certificate, and (2) A-Star Limousine paid the \$1,000 non-suspended portion of the penalty in accordance with the payment schedule.

On March 13, 2019, the company paid the \$1,000 portion of the penalty that was not suspended. To date, the company has refrained from further operations as a charter or excursion service carrier in this state. Staff finds that A-Star Limousine satisfied the conditions of Order 02 and recommends the \$9,000 suspended penalty be waived.
