Notify customers on the first bill as stated in WAC 480-70-271 (2)(a). This would occur March 1, 2025.

*** Explain why the company is proposing this tariff revision:**
The Company received notification of a Tip Fee increase impacting the Company effective March 1, 2025.

*** Explain why the Commission should allow this tariff revision to take effect with less than 30 days' notice (45 days' notice for solid waste):**
The historic practice is to notify customers of a tip fee increase on the first bill per WAC 480-70-271(2)(a) this allows us to keep rate payer costs down by avoiding unnecessary additional printing and postage.
