RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Docket UE-001734

TO ALL PARTIES:

On November 27, 2002, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered its Final Order in the above-referenced docket, which rejected Pacific Power & Light Company's (Pacific Power or Company) original proposed tariff revision and approved its modified tariff proposal (Final Order). The Final Order required Pacific Power to make annual compliance filings reporting the number of times Rules 4 and 6 of its Permanent Disconnection and Removal Tariff were used, and, for each transaction: the date, customer type, nature of the request, estimated removal cost and salvage, actual removal cost and salvage, description of the facilities removed, and the accounts used to book the transaction.

On February 21, 2018, the Company made its annual Compliance Filing for 2017.

On May 9, 2018, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that Staff believes the Company's filing complies fully with the Commission's Final Order.

The Commission accepts the Compliance Filing as compliant with the terms of the Final Order in this docket.
