As referenced in Integra Telecom of Washington, Inc.'s Response to the Data Requests in Order No. 6, Integra purchases products and services from Qwest Communications in the State of Washington. Per Order No. 6, Qwest was suppose to provide Integra data information for certification on or before July 18, 2003. Then, per your order, Integra was to certify that information on or before July 25, 2003.

Integra received the information from Qwest yesterday, July 23, 2003 at 11:28 am. A true and accurate copy of the transmittal email is attached hereto as Exhibit A. Integra has not attached the information that Qwest supplied as those attachments contain

information that is highly confidential to Integra and protected under the terms of the Protective Order.

Integra immediately began its review of the information, but will not be able to complete that review by July 25, 2003.

Integra hereby request an extension. Integra will complete its review and submit its certification as soon as possible, but Integra requests an extension to July 30, 2003 to grant Integra the seven day period originally allowed for review and certification of this information from Qwest.
