The Broadband Communications Association of Washington ("BCAW"), on behalf of its member companies,¹ respectfully submits these Comments pursuant to the State of Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's ("Commission") May 27, 2015 Notice of Opportunity to Respond to the Small Business Economic Impact Statement (SBEIS) Questionnaire ("Notice"), regarding the economic impact of the Commission's (Draft) Rules to Implement RCW 80.54, Relating to Attachments to Transmission Facilities (hereinafter "Rules").

BCAW is the trade association representing cable operators doing business in the State of Washington, and companies servicing the cable industry. BCAW members are continually working and investing to deliver state of the art services to Washington's citizens. BCAW members invest \$365 million annually to bring the state's residents and enterprises leading edge broadband services including, high-speed broadband internet, home security and a full range of advanced video and voice services.

While it is difficult for BCAW to calculate and provide information regarding the potential cost impact of the Rules on its members, the Commission's adoption of Rules modeled
