**TO ALL PARTIES:**

On April 30, 2019, Avista Corporation, d/b/a Avista Utilities (Avista or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions to its currently effective Tariff WN U-28, Electric Service, in Docket UE-190334 and revisions to its currently effective Tariff WN U-29, Natural Gas, in Docket UG-190335.

On March 29, 2019, Avista filed with the Commission tariff revisions designed to rebate to customers approximately \$34.4 million in Docket UE-190222.

On May 30, 2019, the Commission issued Order 03, consolidating Dockets UE-190334, UG-190335, and UE-190222.

On April 30, 2019, Puget Sound Energy (PSE) filed its 2019 Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) in Docket UE-190324, and on June 3, 2019, Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power) filed its 2019 Power Cost Adjustment Mechanism (PCAM) in Docket UE-190458.

On September 26, 2019, Commission staff (Staff) submitted a request to suspend the filings in Dockets UE-190324 and UE-190458. Staff also moved to sever Avista's ERM filing, Docket UE-190222, from Avista's general rate case and consolidate it with Dockets UE-

190324 and UE-190458. Staff moved that the Commission set a Prehearing Conference in all three dockets. Staff also moved to suspend the October 3, 2019, testimony filing deadline in Docket UE-190222. Staff indicated that no non-company party to Docket UE-190222 opposed its motion to suspend the testimony filing deadline.

Commission rules require parties to file any response to Staff's motion to suspend the testimony filing deadline within 3 business days. Accordingly, responses to Staff's motion to suspend the testimony deadline in Docket UE-190222 are due by 5 p.m. on Tuesday, October 1, 2019.

Due to the number of parties and issues involved, the Commission finds good cause to afford parties until October 10, 2019, to respond to Staff's other motions.

**THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That any party intending to respond to Staff's motion to suspend the October 3, 2019, testimony filing deadline in Docket UE-190222 must file a written response by 5 p.m. on Tuesday, October 1, 2019.**

**THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That any party intending to file a response to Staff's September 26, 2019, motion, with the exception of Staff's motion to suspend the testimony deadline of October 3, 2019, in Docket UE-190222, must file a written response by October 10, 2019.**
