Dear Judge Russell or Judge Rendahl:

Staff of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Staff) and Intelligent Community Services, Inc. (ICS) request that the due date for rebuttal/cross-answering testimony (September 26) be continued to October 24, 2008. The reason for the requested continuance is that both of these parties have lost their witnesses. Mark Vasconi has left the Commission's employ, and Keith Southard has left the employ of ICS.

The date of October 24, 2008, however, is provisional because the parties will need to consult their replacement witnesses once they have them, and because the parties have not been able to consult Mr. Finnigan, counsel to the remaining parties in this matter, who currently is unavailable (out of the country until September 24).
