CWA, INC.'S OBJECTION TO PORTIONS OF THE PREHEARING CONFERENCE ORDER

CWA, Inc. ("CWA") files this Objection to Portions of the Prehearing Conference
Order issued on December 9, 2004 ("Order"), pursuant to WAC 480-07-430(3). Specifically,
CWA objects to the Order's statement that "[a]t the prehearing conference, CWA withdrew
its protest to the [Diamond-West] application." *See* Order at ¶ 8. There has apparently been
a misunderstanding, because CWA's counsel did not intend to withdraw CWA's protest.
CWA intends to enter into a stipulation with Diamond-West that will contain a mutuallyagreeable restriction on the authority that Diamond West seeks. CWA wants to remain a
party to this proceeding to ensure that the Commission adopts the authority as agreed to by
the parties or with amendments that are acceptable to CWA. If the Commission rejects the
filed amendment, CWA will request a continuance of the hearing so that it can prepare a case
and present witnesses. For these reasons, CWA respectfully requests the Administrative Law
Judge to revise the Order so that CWA remains a party to this proceeding.
