

Based upon information known to me or provided to me by employees responsible for the preparation of data, I hereby state as follows:

1. USCC was designated as an eligible telecommunications carrier ("ETC") by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission in Docket No. UT-970345 on December 23, 1997, as supplemented December 30, 1999 and January 27, 2000.
2. During the calendar year 2004, USCC provided the services required by 47 U.S.C. § 214(e) consistent with the Commission Orders in Docket No. UT-970345.
3. During the calendar year 2004, USCC advertised the availability of supported services and the charges for them as required by 47 U.S.C. § 214(e), and the Commission Orders in Docket No. UT-9070345. Outreach activities included newspaper advertising, informational postings at www.uscellular.com, advertising collateral located in retail locations and the ability for potential Native American Lifeline customers in the Yakima, Washington area to sign up for service at select retail locations.

4. USCC has received the following federal high-cost universal service fund support for the months of January – December 2004:



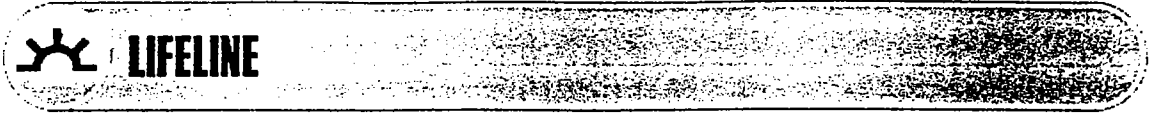

Lifeline Qualifications

Qualifications vary by state. If you meet the requirements in one of the following three sections, you may be eligible for one of the U.S. Cellular Lifeline plans.

Option 1

Residents in states that provide state support must meet the criteria established by the state commission. State commissions are required to establish narrowly targeted eligibility criteria based on income or factors directly related to income. In states that do not provide state support, individuals may be eligible for Lifeline if they currently participate in one or more of the following programs:

- Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) or any official Home Energy Assistance Program
- Federal Public Housing Assistance or Section 8
- Medicaid
- Food Stamps
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
- National School Lunch free lunch program

Option 2 (For Iowa residents only)

An individual may be eligible for Lifeline services if his or her household income is at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.

Option 3

Beginning in October of 2000, the Low Income Program was expanded to provide additional support to low-income consumers living on reservations, consistent with the FCC's Tribal Lands Order.

Broader qualification criteria for Lifeline were established to include means-tested or income-based programs in which low-income individuals living on reservations are more likely to participate. Individuals living on reservations may rely on participation in any of the following programs to establish eligibility:

- Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) general assistance
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
- Head Start (if income eligible)
- Tribal TANF
- Free meals under the National School Lunch Program

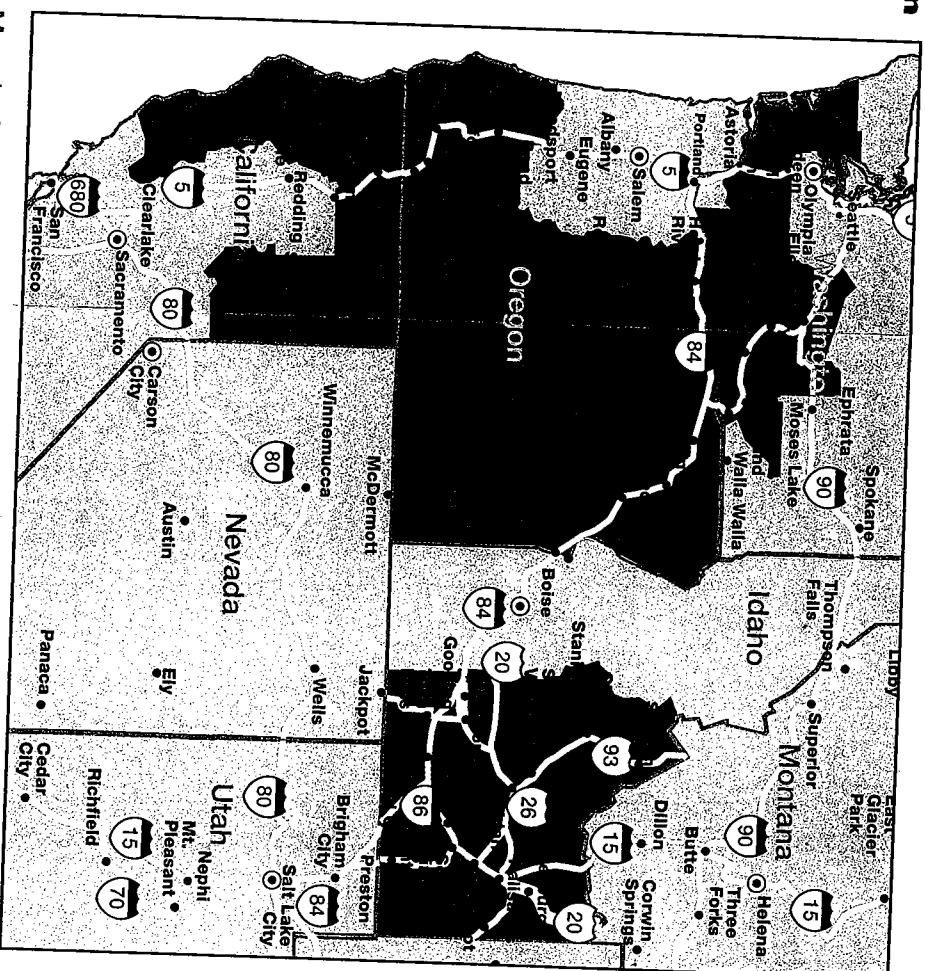

The Noon Rotary Club was joined by members of other Lower Valley Rotary Clubs in welcoming a group of Rotarians from Australia.

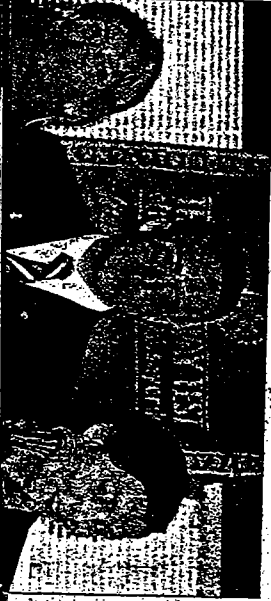
Rotary clubs, including ones in Bremerton, Moses Lake, Wenatchee, and Pullman, were at home on Sunday, May 14.
