The stated effective date is March 16, 2006. Cascade's filing seeks Commission authorization to increase its rates and charges for natural gas service by \$11.7 million, or 4.5 percent on an annual basis.

The filing would increase charges and rates for service provided by Cascade. Because those increases might injuriously affect the rights and interests of the public and Cascade has not demonstrated that the increases would result in rates that are fair, just and reasonable, the Commission suspends the tariff filing and will hold public hearings if necessary to determine whether the proposed increases are fair, just and reasonable.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

- The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission is an agency of the State of Washington vested by statute with the authority to regulate rates, regulations, practices, accounts, securities, and transfers of public service companies, including natural gas companies. RCW 80.01.040, Chapter 80.04 RCW, Chapter 80.28 RCW, Chapter 80.08 RCW and Chapter 80.12 RCW.
- 4 (2) Cascade is a natural gas company and is a public service company subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.
- This matter was brought before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on March 15, 2006.
- 6 (4) The tariff revisions filed by Cascade on February 14, 2006, would increase charges and rates for service provided by Cascade, and might injuriously affect the rights and interest of the public.
- 7 (5) Cascade has not yet demonstrated that the tariff revisions would result in rates that are fair, just and reasonable.

- In order to carry out the duties imposed upon the Commission by law, and as authorized in RCW 80.04.130, the Commission believes it is necessary to investigate Cascade's books, accounts, practices and activities; to make a valuation or appraisal of Cascade's property; and to investigate and appraise various phases of Cascade's operations.
- 9 (7) As required by RCW 80.04.130 (4), Cascade bears the burden of proof to show that the proposed increases are fair, just and reasonable.
- 10 (8) Cascade may be required to pay the expenses reasonably attributable and allocable to such an investigation to the extent the requirements for such payment are in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 80.20 RCW.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 11 (1) The tariff revisions filed on February 14, 2006, are suspended.
- 12 (2) The Commission will hold hearings at such times and places as may be required.
- 13 (3) Cascade Natural Gas Corporation must not change or alter the tariffs filed in this docket during the suspension period, unless authorized by the Commission.
- 14 (4) The Commission will institute an investigation of Cascade Natural Gas
 Corporation's books, accounts, practices, activities, property and operations as
 described above.
- 15 (5) Cascade Natural Gas Corporation shall pay the expenses reasonably attributable and allocable to the Commission's investigation to the extent the requirements for such payment are in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 80.20 RCW.
