## NOTICE SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND NOTICE CANCELING HEARING (Set for July 14, 2014)

RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Seventh Generation,
Docket TE-140414

## TO ALL PARTIES:

On April 17, 2014, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) brought a complaint against Seventh Generation following the allegation that Seventh Generation engaged in business as a charter party carrier in February 2014by completing two trips from Kent to Snoqualmie Summit East for Mohan Skiing and Boarding. The Commission convened a prehearing conference in this docket on May 19, 2014, and adopted a procedural schedule for this proceeding, including setting an evidentiary hearing for July 14, 2014.

On May 29, 2014, Commission Staff (staff) on behalf of the parties filed with the Commission a settlement agreement and narrative that would resolve all issues in this docket. Staff requests that the Commission suspend the procedural schedule, pending Commission consideration and decision regarding the settlement.

The Commission finds good cause to suspend the procedural schedule and therefore grants the parties' request.
