RE: *In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against Island Airporter LLC in the Amount of \$14,500*
Docket TC-180268

TO ALL PARTIES:

On May 14, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a penalty assessment (Penalty Assessment) against Island Airporter LLC (Island Airporter or Company) in the Amount of \$14,500 for 145 violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-30.

On May 14, 2018, Island Airporter responded to the Penalty Assessment, admitting the violations and requesting mitigation of the penalty. On May 25, 2018, Commission staff (Staff) filed a response recommending the Commission grant the Company's request for mitigation, in part.

On June 8, 2018, the Commission entered Order 01, Order Granting Mitigation to \$7,000; Suspending Penalty in Part (Order 01). Order 01 suspended \$5,500 of the remaining penalty for a period of two years subject to the conditions that Island Airporter (1) pay the remaining \$1,500 of the penalty, and (2) not incur any repeat violations of 49 C.F.R. §387.31(a) upon reinspection.

On May 28, 2020, Staff filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that the Company had timely paid the \$1,500 portion of the penalty that was not suspended and that during a follow-up investigation Staff discovered no further violations of 49 C.F.R. §387.31(a). Staff recommends the suspended penalty be waived.

The Commission finds that Island Airporter has complied with the conditions of Order 01. The \$5,500 portion of the penalty that was suspended is now waived, and this docket is closed.
