NOTICE SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

AND

**NOTICE REQUIRING FILING OF SETTLEMENT
DOCUMENTS OR STATUS REPORT
(Due by September 14, 2018)**

Re: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, Complainant, v. JFS Transport, Inc. d/b/a Coast Movers, Respondent, Docket TV-180315.*

On June 20, 2018, the regulatory staff (Staff) of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) filed a Complaint against JFS Transport, Inc. d/b/a Coast Movers (JFS or Respondent), alleging seven causes of action. The Complaint requested that the Commission impose monetary penalties on Respondent for violations of Commission rules and state laws and order Respondent to refund excess charges to customers who were overcharged by JFS.

On August 10, 2018, after receiving notification from the Commission's regulatory staff (Staff) that the parties reached a settlement in principle, the Commission suspended the procedural schedule and directed the parties to file a settlement proposal, or at the least, a status report no later than August 31, 2018.

On August 31, 2018, the parties filed a letter stating that they "are still working to finalize their settlement agreement and supporting documentation, including a compliance plan."¹ The parties request a continuance of the suspension of the procedural schedule such that they will file the settlement and supporting narrative, or at the least, a status report no later than September 14, 2018.

Pursuant to WAC 480-07-385, the Commission finds good cause to continue to suspend the procedural schedule and therefore grants the parties' request. The parties must file a settlement agreement and supporting documentation or a report on the status of their settlement negotiations by September 14, 2018.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the procedural schedule in this matter is suspended. By September 14, 2018, the parties must either file a settlement agreement and supporting documentation or a status report of their negotiations.
