RATE INCREASE NOTICE FOR RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE & RECYCLING SERVICES

Dear Customer:

April 30, 2018

Harold LeMay Enterprises, Inc. has filed a request for a rate increase with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (WUTC). The last general rate increase was approved by the WUTC January 1, 2011. Since that time, the Company has invested in new capital and experienced increases in operating costs in the areas of labor, employee benefits, fuel, parts and equipment amongst other categories which it now seeks to update in rates.

If approved, the proposed rates will become effective June 1, 2018. The rate per month will increase as follows:
