Dear Secretary Johnson,

Enclosed please find revised tariff pages and worksheets for Nooksack Valley Disposal permit G-166. This is an adjustment to the recycling commodity tracker as detailed in WAC 480-70-351.

We have made the annual review of commodity values and adjusted Note 3 of Item 100. This adjustment will change the charges to residential recycling customers as a result of a calculation of the recycling tracker using the last twelve months of recycling commodity values. The current **credit** is \$.07 per customer per month. The proposed **debit** is \$.34 per customer per month. Please note that this is **not** the first commodity adjustment filing for our company which is resulting in a charge. The expected impact to the company is an increase in annual revenue of \$11,302. We have requested an effective date of December 1, 2018, the date the old rates expire.

Notice will be given to our customers and to the Whatcom County Council at the time of our next billing, after rates have been approved.
