## TO ALL PARTIES:

On January 2, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued an order instituting a special proceeding on its own motion to determine whether Sunrise Acres Water Services, LLC (Sunrise Acres or Company) may be engaged in business as a water company subject to the Commission's jurisdiction without the requisite authority. The Commission gave notice of an evidentiary hearing set for February 4, 2019, at 1:30 p.m.

On the morning of February 4, 2019, an associate of Tom Harrison, the owner of Sunrise Acres, informed the Commission that Mr. Harrison would not be able to attend the hearing due to a Company emergency. Given the Company's emergency and adverse weather conditions, the Commission issued a Notice Cancelling Evidentiary Hearing on February 4, 2019. On February 6, 2019, Sunrise Acres and Commission Staff agreed to reschedule the hearing to February 28, 2019.
