## **RATE INCREASE NOTICE FOR RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE, RECYCLING AND YARD WASTE**

Harold LeMay Enterprises, Inc. has filed a request for a rate increase with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (WUTC). The last general rate increase was approved by the WUTC November 1, 2011. Since that time, the Company has experienced higher costs for employee wages, benefits, fuel, truck equipment and has purchased additional capital assets.

As part of this filing Pierce County Refuse will begin providing garbage and recycling services to customers who reside in the Ashford and Elbe areas of Pierce County. Harold LeMay Enterprises, Inc. dba, City Sanitary, Joe's Refuse, White Pass Garbage currently provides garbage service and Pierce County Refuse provides recycling service. To comply with Pierce County Refuse tariff provisions customers will be required to utilize a company owned cart for garbage service, and pay for every-other-week recycling service.

If approved by the WUTC, the proposed rates below will become effective March 1, 2020.
