TO ALL PARTIES:

On October 9, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Order Granting Mitigation to \$10,400 (Order 01) against Peninsula Sanitation Services, Inc. (Peninsula Sanitation or Company). Order 01 assessed a penalty of \$10,400 against the Company, \$5,200 of which was suspended for two years, to be waived thereafter, subject to the conditions that: 1) the Company not incur any repeat violations of critical or acuter regulations upon reinspection; and 2) the Company pay the \$5,200 portion of the penalty that was not suspended.

On October 21, 2020, Peninsula Sanitation paid the \$5,200 portion of the penalty that was not suspended.

On December 2, 2022, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that Staff had conducted a follow-up inspection, and that the Company had not incurred any repeat violations of acute or critical violations.

The Commission finds that Peninsula Sanitation has complied with the conditions of Order 01. The \$5,200 suspended portion of the penalty is now waived, and this docket is closed.
