**NOTICE CANCELLING BRIEF ADJUDICATIVE PROCEEDING**

RE: *In the Matter of the Investigation of John Frank LLC for Compliance with WAC 480-15-560 and WAC 480-15-555,

TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 26, 2024, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Intent to Cancel Permit as a Household Goods Carrier, Notice of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding, Setting Time for Oral Statements (set for October 24, 2024, at 9:30 a.m.).

On October 23, 2024, Commission staff (Staff) notified the Commission that it accepted the Company's safety management plan and is working to resolve this matter and bring the Company into compliance. Staff requested that the Commission cancel the scheduled brief adjudicative proceeding and indicated that Staff will be submitting the form for waiver and is requesting a paper-record decision. In the event the parties reach an agreement they will be required to provide a copy of any settlement reached for the presiding administrative law judge's review and approval. If the parties are unable to reach an agreement, then they will be required to contact the Commission and Presiding Administrative Law Judge to reschedule a brief adjudicative proceeding and file any updated documentation not already captured in the record.

The Commission finds good cause to cancel the brief adjudicative proceeding currently set for October 24, 2024.
