This is a complaint proceeding on a complaint by Cascade Moving and Storage, Inc., against Cascade Trucking, Inc., d/b/a Cascade Movers.

A hearing was held upon this complaint on August 15, 1995, before Administrative Law Judge Marjorie R. Schaer.

On January 3, 1996, the administrative law judge entered an Initial Order granting the complaint and ordering the respondent to cease and desist from use of the name "Cascade" in conjunction with the name "Movers", "Moving", or "Transfer". The initial order was served on all parties of record.

No petition for administrative review was filed within the 20 days allowed by rule for filing. In accordance with RCW 34.05.464 and WAC 489-09-780(6), the Commission accepts the findings of fact and conclusions of law, and adopts the Initial Order Granting Complaint, Ordering Respondent to Cease and Desist, as its own for purposes of this proceeding.

## ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS That the Initial Order Granting Complaint, Ordering Respondent to Cease and Desist is affirmed and adopted for purposes of this proceeding. In so doing,

THE COMMISSION FURTHER ORDERS That the respondent cease and desist from use of the name "Cascade" in conjunction with the name "movers", "Moving", or "Transfer".
