On October 1, 2003 One Eighty Networks completed the acquisition of all the operations and assets of Highspeed Communications in Washington state. This includes their CLEC operations, Qwest Interconnection, Qwest Collocate, etc. At this time we are working through an orderly transition from Highspeed Communications to One Eighty Networks. Part of that transition includes the transfer of all Qwest loops, collocates, and other network elements used to provide service to the former Highspeed Communications customers. Qwest requires an amendment to the Highspeed Communications Interconnection Agreement to add language defining the charges, timelines, and other Terms & Conditions associated with the transfer to One Eighty Networks. We have requested this Amendment to the Highspeed Communications Interconnection Agreement with Qwest to allow us to complete that transfer and shut down any and all remaining telecommunications business for Highspeed Communications in the State of Washington.

We understand that Highspeed Communications had their CLEC Certificate revoked and that normally this Amendment would not be approved. We respectfully request that the Commission approve this Amendment for the sole purpose of allowing us to complete the shut down of all remaining Highspeed Communications operations in the State of Washington.
