Enclosed for filing are an original and five copies of Qwest's compliance filing in accordance with the requirements of Order No. 06. That order became final on June 13, 2008, and paragraph 53 required Qwest to "make a compliance filing including updated and "clean" versions of each of the affected exhibits to Qwest's Statement of Generally Available Terms (SGAT), specifically the Performance Indicator Definitions (PIDs are Exhibit B to SGAT) and the Qwest Performance Assurance Plan (PAP is Exhibit K to SGAT)."

Qwest is therefore filing clean and redlined versions of the Exhibit K (PAP) and the Exhibit B (PIDs). The compliance documents mirror the redlined versions filed with the partial settlement agreement except for the following:

Exhibit K

- 1) Language associated with disputed issues has been restored to the status quo.
- 2) Attachment 1 footnotes are now different than the footnotes referenced in the partial settlement filing and the ALJ's order due to the restoration of footnote "c" which was to be deleted as part of the denied "one allowable miss" proposed change. For example, the partial settlement filing and the order references footnote "h" as part of the resolution of the EDI to XML issue but with footnote "c" remaining, footnote "i" is now the relevant footnote to the EDI to XML issue's resolution.

- 3) Consistent with the changes from "QPAP" to "PAP" throughout the Exhibit K, Qwest changed one (1) remaining instance of QPAP to PAP in Attachment 3.
- 4) Attachment 3 to Exhibit K also had an EDI to XML change that the parties overlooked initially.

Exhibit B

The only difference between the previously filed versions and these is in the Availability 1) sections of the XML impacted PIDs. These PIDs have specific availability information rather than "TBD" or "XML reporting under development."
