RE: Deactivated Gas Line Inspection and Remediation Program (Docket PG-160924)

Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement approved in Docket PG-160924, Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) hereby submits the following update and amended plan based on the findings of inspections described in Appendix A - Deactivated Gas Line Inspection and Remediation Program (“Program”).

The Program calls for PSE to inspect four populations of retired gas services and to conduct remediation based on the results of those inspections. PSE inspected 100% of Population 1 services by December 13, 2018. In addition, PSE completed the inspections for Population 2, 3, & 4 samples as of January 2019, ahead of the schedule established in the Settlement Agreement. Based on the results of the sample inspections, and pursuant to the “Identification” provisions of the Program, PSE will undertake inspections of the entirety of each of the remaining three populations. PSE plans to complete all remaining inspections by December 19, 2020.

Because the Program expressly contemplates the additional inspections and specifically instructs PSE to file this amended plan, no action is necessary on the part of the Commission or the other parties in this proceeding.
