NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Washington Exchange Carrier Association, Docket UT-971140

TO ALL PARTIES:

On May 23, 2014, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 10, Order Terminating Traditional USF Fund (Order 10), in the above-referenced docket. Order 10 eliminates the Traditional USF intrastate access charge element effective August 1, 2014. All Local Exchange Carriers (LECs), both Incumbent and Competitive LECs, must eliminate the Traditional USF rate element of \$0.00152 from their intrastate access charge tariffs, price lists, and catalogs.

In accordance with Order 10 the Commission received the following compliance filings eliminating the Traditional USF rate element of \$0.00152:
