Pursuant to the Notice of Opportunity to File Responses to Covad's Petition for Review and Clarification of Order No. 05, Integra Telecom of Washington, Inc. ("Integra") files this letter in support of Covad's motion. In compliance with the orders in this case, the original of this letter and twelve copies are included.

Beginning at Page 13 of Integra's Motion for Summary Disposition, Integra addresses the issue of where the obligation to file rests under Section 252. While the Commission did not accept those arguments in Order No. 05, Covad's Petition for Review, which is based on the FCC's Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture ("NAL"), 1 presents an excellent opportunity to revisit the issue.

Rather than burdening the record with duplicative arguments, Integra wishes to be on record as supporting Covad's Motion. Further, Integra believes that based on the NAL, the Commission should reconsider Order No. 05 as it relates to all CLECs. Integra urges the Commission to hold that, in light of NAL, the duty to file the agreements rests with Qwest, not the CLECs.
