TO ALL PARTIES:

On October 30, 2020, Avista Corporation, d/b/a Avista Utilities, (Avista or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions to its currently effective electric and natural gas service tariffs, Tariffs WN U-28 and WN U-29, in Dockets UE-200900 and UG-200901 that are designed to effect a general rate increase for its electric and natural gas services (general rate case, or GRC), and also an accounting petition in Docket UE-200894 for costs associated with its wildfire resiliency plan (Petition). On December 23, 2020, the Commission entered Order 04/01, consolidating the three dockets.

On December 21, 2021, the Commission entered its Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing, which established a procedural schedule that allowed for a public comment hearing to be scheduled at a later date.

The Commission now establishes the time and place for a virtual public comment hearing to provide members of the public with an opportunity to present oral comments to the Commission.
