Dear Judge Russell or Judge Rendahl:

The parties in this proceeding, Staff of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Staff), Intelligent Community Services, Inc. (ICS), and Washington Independent Telecommunications Association/Inland (WITA/Inland), respectfully request modification of the remainder of the procedural schedule.

Last month, Staff and ICS requested that the due date for filing rebuttal/cross-answering testimony be set out to October 24 to allow Staff and ICS time to identify witnesses to replace those who had recently left ICS and the Commission respectively. As the two parties indicated at that time, the new date that was proposed for rebuttal/cross-answering testimony was provisional, given that neither ICS nor Staff had replacement witnesses and that counsel for WITA/Inland was unavailable for consultation about the schedule.

At this time, the parties request that both the hearing date and the deadline for filing rebuttal/cross-answering testimony be canceled and that the Commission set a date during the week of November 3rd to conduct an informal scheduling conference to allow the parties to resolve outstanding scheduling issues.

The parties appreciate the Commission's consideration of their request.
